



Did you know...

...that 55% of BC sports organizations surveyed know of athletes who have dropped out of sport because of bullying? A sport environment in which participants - athletes, coaches, volunteers, and officials - are exposed to negative experiences such as bullying can be harmful and cause individuals to quit. That's why viaSport and the Government of B.C. have launched a new #ERASEbullying initiative for every provincial and local sport organization, and all B.C. citizens. On February 22, 2017, provincial sport organizations will celebrate the Province's first Declaration of Commitment to erase bullying in sport across B.C. The 2017 BC Archery fee structure is as follows:

- Youth, up to 17 years old: \$60
- Adults, 18 and older: \$70
- Family, max 2 adults + unlimited youth in same household: \$150
- Club: \$150

High Performance Funding applications — LAST CALL

Last call for Athlete Funding applications. **Deadline is Jan 31 2017** for 2016 activities.

An application requires your 2016 Training Plan working with a coach that has a minimum certification as Instruction of Intermediate Archers (old Level 2).

Your coach must validate that they have been working with you in a reporting manner.


