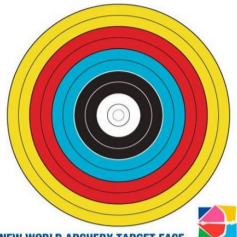

There is talk about a new indoor compound target that will change the sizes of the 9 through 6 ring so that they are proportional, and "look" better for the spectators. We have venue information!

The Archery Competition for the AMG2016 will take place at UBC on the Arthur Lord & Frank Buck fields, right beside the Rugby Centre. Eight sports will be competing on the UBC grounds so there will be lots of energy and activity (including a Beer Garden close by!!)

Archery will take place from August 27th to 31st. Competition will be based on gender (M/F), age (50-59, 60-69, 70+), and equipment (Compound, Recurve & Barebow).

The event consists of 2 days of qualifying rounds (a 720-round each day) and a day of single-elimination rounds.

Recurves shoot 60m on a 122cm target, Barebows shoot 50m on a 122cm target, and Compounds shoot 50m on a 6-ring (cut-down) 80cm target (only blue, red & yellow rings showing).
