### Did you know...

...the first Canada Winter Games was in 1967 in Quebec City? 1800 athletes from all over Canada competed in 15 sports. The Winter Games are held every 4 years and move to different provinces and territories across the country. The 2019 Games in Red Deer, Alberta, are expected to host **3600 athletes and coaches and feature 19 sports**. Alberta has hosted the CWG twice before, and this event is expected to be the largest event hosted by the province since the 1988 Calgary Olympics! ### Archery TeamBC at CWG2019

January 23 marked the one month count down until our archery team departs for Red Deer AB along with the rest of Team BC. The Canada Winter Games features 19 sports and over 150 events including an arts and culture festival.

Since our [team selection camp](#) took place in Oliver in November, our team has been hard at work preparing for the Games. Competition at the Winter Games will consist of two days of individual/team qualifications, followed by one day of individual eliminations and one day of team eliminations.

TSN/RDS is the official games broadcaster and Sports Canada TV will live stream every sport with over 1200 hours of coverage for the event. ### Memberships expired December 31st

The fastest way to renew/join is to [complete the online form and pay with a credit card](#). Your new card will be emailed to you. (Please allow at least 2 weeks for processing as Jan/Feb is a busy time for renewals).

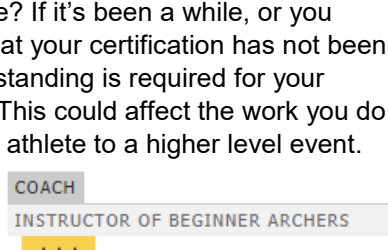
Keeping your membership current is important. It is needed if you want to participate at a registered event or Championship, or even to practice at some clubs. If you do any coaching or judging, a current membership is required in order for your certification to be recognized. If you are working on coaching or judging certification, your membership must be current. And if your club is relying on you to be one of their named Safety Officers, Judges or Coaches, the Club membership cannot be renewed until your personal membership has been.

Clubs: club renewals were due by January 1st. If you need an Insurance Certificate or run a JOP program, you may face delays if the club membership has not been renewed. To avoid further processing delays, anyone listed as the Club's Coaches, Safety Officers/ Judges should renew at the same time as the Club renews. The Club renewal will be held until those persons are listed as "in-good-standing" for 2019. Please also be reminded that you cannot host registered events until your club has a 2019 membership, nor can your JOP participants receive any awards/certificates.

### Has your Coaching certification expired?

When was the last time you checked your [Locker](#) profile? If it's been a while, or you haven't taken any courses recently, there's a chance that your certification has not been renewed by the NCCP. An NCCP-certification in-good-standing is required for your coaching certification to be recognized by BC Archery. This could affect the work you do at your club, in private, or if you want to take a Team or athlete to a higher level event.

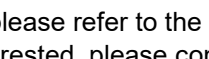
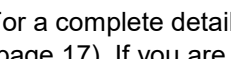
